8 ORDER

9 WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration upon the  
10 Court's own motion to establish a policy governing the use of  
11 cellular telephones issued by the Administrative Office of the  
12 Courts, and the Court being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice  
13 Gene E. Franchini, Justice Joseph F. Baca, Justice Pamela B.  
14 Minzner, Justice Patricio M. Serna, and Justice Dan A.  
15 McKinnon, III, concurring;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the following policy  
17 governing the use of cellular telephones issued by the  
18 Administrative Office of the Courts shall be effective  
19 immediately:

20 CELLULAR TELEPHONE POLICY

21 Office and cellular telephones are intended for  
22 business use. The Supreme Court recognizes that it  
23 occasionally may be necessary to make a personal long  
24 distance call or a personal call from cellular  
25 telephone. The Administrative Office of the Courts  
26 must be reimbursed for all personal long distance  
27 calls and all personal cellular telephone calls.  
28 Employees will receive monthly call detail reports.  
It is each employee's responsibility to review their  
long distance and cellular telephone calls to  
identify business and personal calls. Reimbursement  
checks for personal calls shall be made payable to  
"Administrative Office of the Courts."
